SCOFFLAW ABATEMENT

ARTICLE I AUTHORITY

3.1.01 California Vehicle Code Sections 22651(i)(1) and 22651.7 allow Parking Services employees to remove or immobilize vehicles with a device designed and manufactured for the immobilization of vehicles...when the vehicle is found to have been issued five or more notices of parking violations which are delinquent because the owner has not responded.

ARTICLE II VEHICLE REMOVAL OR IMMOBILIZATION

3.1.02 The intent of Parking Services is to limit the amount of scofflaws by removing or immobilizing vehicles that have five or more citations that are delinquent. Delinquency is determined by the owner of the vehicle not responding to Parking Management Bureau within 21 days from the issuance of a citation or 14 days from the mailing of the notice for a delinquent parking violation.

3.1.03 Removal of the immobilizing device will be done when the owner of the vehicle has provided Parking Services evidence of their identity and address within the state of California where he or she may be reached, and satisfactory evidence that the full amount of parking penalties has been deposited to cover all outstanding parking citations.

3.1.04 In lieu of depositing the full amount of parking penalties, the owner may request to see a Parking Services Supervisor. The supervisor will take into account any payment program or reduction in penalties in dealing with the owner of the immobilized or towed vehicle.
