PARKING FEES

ARTICLE I AUTHORITY

2.1.01 Pursuant to Title 5, Article 7, Section 42201(a) of the California Code of Regulations, the University President may grant permission to park on campus, **“to those persons who have paid a parking fee.”**

ARTICLE II DETERMINATION OF PARKING FEES ON CAMPUS

2.2.01 The California State University, Bakersfield President, or their designee, determines the fees to be charged for parking on campus.

2.2.02 Unlike parking citation revenue, parking fees are used for the development, construction, and maintenance of parking lots on campus. The intent of collecting fees is to provide the University with the needed revenue to meet the needs of all that park on campus.

2.2.03 Parking Fees are currently set at:

Quarterly Permit	\$36 Automobile	\$9 Motorcycle
Daily Permits	\$2.00 per day	
Metered Spaces (one hour maximum)	\$1.00 per hour, \$0.50 per 30 minutes, \$0.25 per 15 minutes	
Activities Permit	\$15 per quarter	

(These fees may change without notice)

2.2.04 Parking fees may be waived for special guests or events that do not charge an admission fee. Parking permits or arrangements may be obtained by contacting University Parking Services in the University Police Department or sending your request to Parking@CSUB.edu.

2.2.05 University organization sponsored events that charge an admission will be charged a minimal parking fee for the use of campus parking lots. Fees are determined as follows:

Amount of Vehicles x \$0.50 per vehicle. (Amount of vehicles = expected attendance / 2)

Expected attendance will be determined by Parking Services based on information provided by the event organizer.

2.2.06 Non-University organization sponsored events will be charged a minimal parking fee for the use of campus parking lots. Fees are determined as follows:

Amount of Vehicles x \$0.75 per vehicle for Events Under Four Hours
Amount of Vehicles x \$1.00 per vehicle for Events Four to Eight Hours

Amount of vehicles = expected attendance / 2

Expected attendance will be determined by Parking Services based on information provided by the event organizer.

2.2.07 Events that are expected to have large numbers of attendees, groups, or individuals may be expected to pay in addition to parking fees, labor costs for the required University Police Department and Parking Services personnel that will be needed for traffic or parking control.
