In the past, students who possessed a baccalaureate degree were required to be formally admitted to a graduate program of study prior to being considered for Federal Title IV Student Financial Aid. Federal regulations now give the campus the ability to be somewhat more flexible in awarding aid to "Unclassified Post-Baccalaureate" students if certain conditions are met. These conditions are as follows:

1. The student must have already applied for admission to the University as a graduate/post-baccalaureate student, AS WELL AS to a graduate, or teacher credential program of study, and be seeking a MA, MS, MBA, MPA, MSW degree or Single or Multiple Subject Teacher Credential.
2. A faculty member and/or advisor designated by your prospective department must complete and sign this form. By completing this form, the faculty member and/or advisor will be certifying that the student is seeking an appropriate degree or teaching credential from CSUB, and outlining what specific courses, or other requirements, must be met by the student in order to be considered for possible admission to that department/program.
3. To be eligible under this exception, the student must be taking courses that are a prerequisite for admission. If the student is taking courses to raise the GPA in order to be admitted, the student does not qualify for aid under this exception.
4. Please note that only those courses listed on this form, as required, can be counted in order to determine if the student satisfies financial aid office enrollment status requirements for aid award.
5. This form is designed to primarily satisfy documentation requirements for the CSUB Office of Financial Aid & Scholarships. Completion of the requirements listed on this form does not guarantee admission to a graduate department at CSUB. Please work carefully with a graduate advisor so that you fully understand the broad range of criteria that will be used to actually determine your admission to a graduate or credential program at CSUB.
6. For Unclassified Post-Baccalaureate students seeking admission to a teacher credential program, financial aid will be based solely on the number of units of enrollment per quarter regardless of course level (e.g., 500-level, 400-level, or 300-level).
