



CSU, BAKERSFIELD SCHOOL OF EDUCATION SECONDARY EDUCATION CREDENTIAL PROGRAM PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The SB 2042 Single Subject Credential Program with AB 1059 approval is designed for those who wish to have a career in teaching. It also prepares teachers to meet the academic needs of English language learners through English language development at the junior high school and senior high levels. This usually means grades 7 through 12. It is designed for both part-time and full-time students. Our program can be completed in an academic year. Courses are offered in the late afternoon and early evening. Fieldwork in a public school setting will be required.

How Do I Apply?

Admission to the University does not constitute admission to the Single Subject Credential Program. Please apply to the university at www.csumentor.edu.

You must attend an Application Orientation Session prior to being admitted. These sessions are held at the beginning of each Quarter. Contact the School of Education at (661) 654-2091 for the exact date and time. Application packets will be available during this time and you will be assigned an advisor according to your subject area. Applications will be due 2 weeks after orientation.

When Do I Apply?

Students must apply *one quarter prior* to starting the program. Application requirements must be complete by the deadline to be admitted. Application deadlines will be announced at the orientation.

What are the Initial Eligibility Requirements?

- **University Admission** - Submit application & be admitted to CSUB as a post-baccalaureate student. You may apply online at www.csub.edu/Admissions with a degree objective of EDUC/CRED.
- **Orientation** - Attend an Application/Orientation Session to receive an application to the program and be assigned an advisor.
- **GPA** – A minimum of 2.67 overall or 2.75 last 90-qtr. units. You may apply for a **Special Admit** if GPA is below the minimum requirement.
- **Subject Matter Competency** – Must be at least 80% complete with subject matter competency (3 courses remaining) in subject area **OR** copy of registration or passage of CSET.
Must be 100% subject matter competent prior to supervised Student Teaching.
- **CBEST** – Provide a copy of scores (Pass or Fail) **OR** proof of registration.
CBEST must be passed prior to Supervised Teaching.
- **Fingerprint Clearance** – Certificate of Clearance, Emergency Permit or Substitute Permit issued by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing. www.ctc.ca.gov
- **TB Certificate** – Current certificate of freedom from Tuberculosis (within 4 years).
- **References** - One faculty and one non-faculty form is provided in the application packet.
- **Interview/Advising** – Interview/advising session with a Secondary Education Faculty Advisor.
- **Written Essay** – To be completed and submitted at orientation.

What are the Pre-Requisites?

Pre-requisite courses must be completed or in progress prior to admission to the credential program.

Candidates must maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0 in all credential course work. A course with a grade lower than a "C" must be repeated.

- *Fingerprint Clearance on file*

Applying for Your Preliminary Credential

To apply for a Preliminary Credential, the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing requires:

1. A bachelor's degree from an accredited University
2. Completion of an accredited teacher preparation program, including supervised student teaching
3. U.S. Constitution
4. Completion of subject matter coursework or exam
5. Passage of CBEST exam
6. Original Certificate of Clearance form
7. Completion of EDBI 475 & EDBI 476
8. CTAP Level I Certificate
9. CPR Certification in Infant, Child & Adults
