CONFLICT OF INTEREST POLICY

Whereas the Associated Students, Incorporated of California State University, Bakersfield are required to maintain a conflict of interest policy to which all student representatives (ASI Executive Officers and members of the Board of Directors) and ASI staff are required to adhere, the following guidelines shall serve as the conflict of interest statement. Furthermore, all student representatives and staff members are required to signify in writing that they understand and will adhere to the policies set forth by this document. Furthermore, student representatives and ASI staff must disclose and keep on record in the ASI office all clubs, groups, and organizations with which each member is affiliates or actively participates.

Members of the Associated Students, Inc. Executive Board and of the Board of Directors are prohibited from engaging in any enterprise or activity (including voting) which results in any of the following:

1. Be financially interested in any contract or other transaction entered into by the Board of which he or she is a member (pursuant to the California Education Code, 89906)
2. Accepting any gift or favor from anyone doing business with ASI with the intention to influence him or her in his or her duties or as a reward for official action
3. Using time, facilities, equipment, or supplies of ASI for the private gain or advantage of himself or herself or another

Furthermore, members of ASI shall not engage in voting for any measure that would have any bearing on a club or organization with which he or she is affiliated.

Each ASI member must sign an affidavit signifying that he or she completely understands and will adhere the aforementioned regulations.
