Responsibilities: The person selected will assist the Director of Track & Field/Cross Country in the day-to-day operations and training of the Pole Vault student athletes. This position will work directly with the athletic teams at California State University, Bakersfield.

Qualifications: Bachelor's degree is required and a minimum of three years of successful NCAA Division I experience is preferred.

Background Check: A background check (including a criminal records check) must be completed satisfactorily before any candidate can be offered a position with the CSU. Failure to satisfactorily complete the background check may affect the application status of applicants or the continued employment of current CSU employees who apply for the position.

Mandated Reporter: The person holding this position is considered a "mandated reporter" under the California Child Abuse and Neglect Reporting Act and is required to comply with the requirements set forth in CSU Executive Order 1083 as a condition of employment.

Compensation: Salary and rank are dependent on qualifications and experience. CSU fulltime hiring range: \$4,530-5,405 / Month
