Gregson Bautzer University Fund Scholarship - FAH (Vol. 6, No. 28)

Students are advised that the Gregson Bautzer University Fund Scholarship was established in 1991 by Mrs. Nicola D. Bautzer in memory of her husband, a former member of the California State University Board of Trustees and the California State University Foundation Board of Governors. This scholarship is open only to incoming freshman students who have graduated from the California Academy of Mathematics and Science and who are continuing their education at any of the California State University campuses.

The California Academy of Mathematics and Science will select two students each academic year. The selection criteria will be based on academic performance and financial need after verification of full-time enrollment status at a CSU campus. Each recipient will receive \$2,000 per academic year for four years while enrolled full-time at a CSU campus. Funds will be disbursed through the campus Financial Aid Offices.
