Indian Health Service Scholarship Programs - FAH (Vol. 7, No. 23)

Students are advised that the Indian Health Service (IHS) Scholarship Application Packets for the 2006-2007 School Cycle are available at the CSUB Office of Financial Aid & Scholarships. The IHS Scholarship is for students interested in, or who are presently in, health related preparatory or professional academic programs. Completed scholarship applications must be in the Area Office designated in the packets by the deadline date of February 28, 2006.

Students may hand carry their applications to any of the Area Offices by/before the deadline date. Should the student mail their application, the application must be postmarked by or before February 28, 2006. A legibly dated receipt from a commercial carrier of the United States Postal Service will be accepted in lieu of a postmark and must be attached to the application. Private metered post marks will not be accepted as proof of timely mailing. Applications post-marked after this date will NOT be accepted and will be returned to the applicant.

In order to have a complete IHS Scholarship Application, students should use the list on the "Application Checklist" form, under NEW, in the Application Information Instruction Booklet. All requested documents must be submitted with the application to comprise a COMPLETE application. OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS only will be accepted. The LETTER OF ADMISSION must be for Fall 2006 and if applying for the Professions level of the Scholarship, the letter must indicate acceptance into the professional level of their program, i.e. Nursing, Pharmacy. General letters of admission are acceptable for most preparatory programs. CERTIFICATION OF TRIBAL MEMBERSHIP must also accompany this application (certification showing Indian blood quantum alone, are not acceptable). Students must SIGN their application wherever a SIGNATURE OF APPLICANT is indicated.
