The AI Muammar Scholarships for Journalism Program - FAH (Vol. 7, No. 4)

Students are advised that the Washington DC-based Arab American Institute Foundation (AAIF) has announced the launching of a new **scholarship program for Arab American students pursuing a career in journalism**. The AAIF is a tax-exempt, not-for-profit, educational organization that conducts the education, outreach, cultural heritage, demographic research and youth leadership programs of the Arab American Institute. Four scholarships of \$5,000 each will be awarded annually by the Arab American Institute Foundation to selected students of Arab descent, who are committed to a career in journalism. Applicants must have a grade-point average of at least 3.30. Academic achievement, financial need, and community service will be considered.

Completed applications must be postmarked no later than **February 15, 2006**. Awardees will be notified in April 2006.
