## Jane M. Klausman Women in Business Scholarships - FAH (Vol. 7, No. 47)

Students are advised that the Zonta Club of the Santa Clarita Valley is pleased to offer the Jane M. Klausman Women in Business Scholarship to assist women entering careers seeking leadership positions in business-related fields. Applicants must be eligible to enter the third or fourth year of an undergraduate business-related degree program.

The Club level scholarship offered is in the amount of \$500. The recipient's application will then be sent to the District level where she will compete for a scholarship of \$350. If she is chosen at the District level, her application will be forwarded to Zonta International where she will be competing for one of six \$5,000 scholarships.

The recipient of the Zonta Club of Santa Clarita Valley scholarship will be invited to the organization's May 10, 2006, business meeting to receive her check.
