HSF Partnership and Internship Programs - FAH (Vol. 7, No. 5)

Students are advised that the Hispanic Scholarship Fund (HSF), in an effort to continue reaching out to Hispanic students, has partnered with corporations and other non-profit groups in developing scholarship programs. Some of the programs listed on <http://www.hsf.net/scholarships.php> involve separate applications and respective deadlines.

Interested students should review the Partnership and Internship Program (PIP) descriptions carefully as these programs have specific eligibility requirements in addition to the general eligibility requirements listed below.

Some programs may not be open at this time. If the program you are interested in is not yet open, please revisit the website during the scholarships application period. **Please note that students may receive only ONE scholarship per academic year from HSF and HSFI.**

In general, to be eligible to apply for a scholarship program, students must:

- Be of Hispanic heritage (one parent must be fully Hispanic or both parents must be half Hispanic)
- Be a U.S. Citizen or a Permanent Resident (with permanent resident card)
- Have earned at least 12 undergraduate college credits in the U.S., Puerto Rico, or the U.S. Virgin Islands, with a minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Be enrolled full-time in a degree-seeking program at a four-year college or university
