## Kern Division California Retired Teachers Scholarship Association - FAH (Vol. 7, No. 52)

Students are advised that the Kern Division California Retired Teachers™ Scholarship Association is pleased to offer, for the 2006-2007 school year, two scholarships of \$2,000 each to CSUB students in the School of Education. ~ One scholarship is for a multiple subject major and one is for a single subject major. ~ The scholarships must be claimed by April 30, 2007.

The student applicant shall:

1. Be a citizen of the United States.
2. Have a high academic standing as evidenced by a transcript of studies. **SUBMIT A TRANSCRIPT OF GRADES WITH THEIR APPLICATION.**
3. Be recommended by the School of Education and submit two faculty member recommendations.
4. Have successfully completed two years of college studies and be planning to enroll in upper division or graduate studies at CSUB in preparation for a professional career in the field of education.
5. Be a trustworthy, constructive citizen interested in the welfare of others as demonstrated through a report of family, school, and community involvement.
6. Be in need of financial assistance.
7. Submit a CSUB scholarship application and two completed recommendation forms to the Office of Financial Aid & Scholarships by April 2, 2006.

These scholarships are locally supported and separate from the Laura E. Settle Scholarship, which is a State of California Retired Teachers™ Association endowed program financed on a statewide level from all the divisions of the association.
