- come from an Hispanic background
- maintain a 3.5 GPA
- be a U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident
- reside and attend college full time in the U.S. or Puerto Rico
- demonstrate financial need
- be pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree in computer science or computer engineering

2. The MasterCard Scholarship Program is for students studying business, finance and technology from California, Texas or the greater metropolitan regions of St. Louis, Miami, or New York City.

Eligibility Requirements

Students must:

- come from an Hispanic background
- maintain a 3.0 GPA
- be a U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident
- reside and attend college full time in the U.S. or Puerto Rico
- demonstrate financial need
- reside in California, Texas or the greater metropolitan regions of St. Louis, Miami, or New York City
- be pursuing an undergraduate degree in business, finance, marketing, accounting, technology

3. The Ford Mi Fuerza Program is for all undergraduates!

- maintain a 3.0 GPA
