The Graydon and Myrth Fox Scholarship - FAH (Vol. 7, No. 63)

Students are advised that the Graydon and Myrth Fox Scholarship was established to assist individuals who are seeking to further their job skills or improve their circumstances through education. This award is available to students who plan to attend an accredited educational institution, including but not limited to colleges and universities, vocational and trade schools and other training programs. There is no age restriction for this scholarship.

Award amount and purpose

The scholarship amount will vary, depending upon the type of academic institution the recipient plans to attend. Award recipients may use funds to cover educational-related costs, including tuition, books, institutional fees, and course related supplies. In order to receive funds, a recipient must submit evidence of full-time enrollment at an accredited educational institution.

Eligibility

To be eligible, an applicant must:

- be planning to attend an accredited educational institution;
- demonstrate financial need;
- be a US citizen with no felony charges;
- complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (www.fafsa.ed.gov);
- file a timely and complete application. Evaluation criteria are weighted as follows: financial need, 50%; career objectives, 50%.

Selection

The selection committee will review each application from eligible candidates. Finalists will be selected based upon how well they meet the scholarship criteria.

How to Apply

Submit a complete application package by the specified due date. In addition to a completed application, you will need to submit:

- a personal statement describing your academic and professional goals;
- a copy of your Student Aid Report (SAR);
- a letter of recommendation from an individual who is not related to you.
