Echo De Valle Chapter of the American Business Women's Association Scholarship - FAH (Vol. 8, No. 27)

Students are advised that the Echo de Valle Chapter, #6004, of the American Business Women's Association (ABWA), in Bakersfield, California, is funding four (4) special scholarships through the Stephen Bufton Memorial Educational Fund (SBMEF). The eligible fields of study are: Nursing, Liberal Studies, Business, Criminal Justice, or Teaching Credential. The scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$2,000 each for two students at Cal State-Bakersfield; and \$1,000 each for two students at Bakersfield Jr. College.

The guidelines are:

- 1) The scholarship is for a one-time issuance and is not automatically renewable.
- 2) Checks for approved candidates are issued to the educational institution for the recipient.
- 3) Funds are limited to tuition, books, and fees.
- 4) ABWA members or individuals who are related to members of the ABWA may apply.

Candidate eligibility requirements are women who:

- are citizens' of the United States of America and a resident of Kern County, California.
- will be a college Freshman, Sophomore, Junior, or Senior level in August, 2007.
- are attending or have been accepted at the California State University, Bakersfield, or Bakersfield Jr. College.
- have achieved a cumulative grade point average (OPA) of 2.5 or better on a 4.0 scale.

The application deadline is **March 30, 2007**. To be considered, the application *must be received by that date* at the National Headquarters of the American Business Women's Association.
