Association of California Water Agencies Scholarship Awards - FAH (Vol. 9, No. 27)

Students are advised that each academic year the Association of California Water Agencies (ACWA) awards scholarships in the amount of **\$3,000** to qualified students in **various water resources-related fields of study**.

The guidelines and criteria for applying for these awards are as follows:

- A. The scholarships will be known as the Association of California Water Agencies Awards, or ACWA Awards. The scholarship funds associated with these awards will be made **available to the recipients at the beginning of each school year at the start of the fall term**.
- B. The applicants who will be considered for the awards must be **California residents attending selected California schools**. They should have completed their sophomore work and at the time of the award be **full-time students in their junior or senior year**. They must plan to attend school for the complete academic year.
- C. The award will be based not only on scholastic achievement, but also on the **individual's commitment and motivation to his / her chosen vocation**. Financial need will also be given due consideration.
- D. The recipient should **demonstrate commitment to the field of water resources** by pursuing a degree related to, or identified with, engineering, agricultural and / or urban water supply, environmental studies or public administration.
- E. The recipients will be selected by the ACWA Scholarship Committee upon receipt of a **completed application form and at least two, but not more than three, recommendations** for each candidate.
- F. The award will be presented to each recipient's school in a lump sum of \$3,000. **Actual payments will be made to each recipient by the school** in accordance with regulations used at the selected school concerning such payment.
- G. Schools selected to participate will be chosen by the Committee from lists of **accredited schools located in California** and recommended by the Association's general membership.
