## **CSUB scholarship opportunities from the National Federation of the Blind (Vol. 9, No. 4)**

Students are advised the National Federation of the Blind (NFB) gives a broad array of scholarships in recognition of achievements by blind scholars.

### Eligibility:

- Must be legally blind.
- Must be pursuing or planning to pursue a full-time, postsecondary course of study in a degree program at a United States' institution in the 2008 scholastic year, with the exception that one scholarship may be given to a person employed full-time while attending school part-time.
- And if chosen as a scholarship recipient, must participate in the entire NFB national convention and in all scheduled scholarship program activities. In addition to the scholarship, each winner will be brought to the National Federation of the Blind convention in July at Federation expense.

**DEADLINE:** All documentation must be received by March 31, 2008. Winners will be notified of their selection by telephone no later than June 1.
