CSUB scholarship opportunities from the Institute of Management Accountants (Vol. 9, No. 5)

Students are advised the Institute of Management Accountants is offering scholarships to undergraduate or graduate IMA student members pursuing study in accounting or finance. Memorial Education Fund (MEF) scholarships range from \$1000 to \$2500; the Stuart Cameron and Margaret McCloud Memorial (SCMS) scholarship is \$5000.

Eligibility:

- Full and part-time (must carry at least six credits per semester) students are encouraged to apply. Note: SCMS Scholarship requires that students must carry 12 credits per semester.
- Scholarships are awarded to students who are physically located in the U.S. or Puerto Rico, studying at regionally accredited institutions.
- Applicant must be an IMA Student Member with the membership number included on the application form.
- The applicant needs to have the expressed intent of pursuing a career in management accounting, financial management, or information.
- A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 is required between all institutions attended throughout the applicant's undergraduate/graduate academic career.

DEADLINE: The deadline for candidates to submit applications to IMA is February 15, 2008.
