⁴ Represents allowance for student's transportation to and from classes and work (bus fare, gasoline, tolls, parking, etc.) Does not include vehicle payments, insurance, repairs, or license fees.

⁵ Represents allowance for student's transportation to and from classes and work (bus fare, gasoline, tolls, parking, etc) and transportation between residence while at college and parents' permanent residence. Does not include vehicle payments, insurance, repairs or license fees.
