## Antelope Valley California Retired Teachers' Association (CRTA) Scholarships - FAH (Vol. 6, No. 39)

Students at the Antelope Valley Campus are advised that the Antelope Valley California Retired Teachers' Association (CRTA) is providing scholarships in the amount of \$500 or more for the 2005-06 academic year. Criteria for the scholarships include the following. Students must:

1. Have completed an AA degree or the equivalent with a GPA of 3.0.
2. Intend to continue in the field of education at an accredited California four-year college on a full-time basis (12 units or more) in the Fall quarter.
3. Have two letters of reference from people not related to you. One letter should be from an instructor in your major.
4. Write and submit a letter stating why you are applying for a scholarship and your educational goals.
5. Submit transcripts from all colleges and universities you have attended.

In order to apply for the scholarships, students are asked to complete the CSUB Academic Scholarship Application at <http://www.csub.edu/FinAid/pdf/ssasap.pdf>, and two CSUB Scholarship Recommendation Forms at <http://www.csub.edu/FinAid/pdf/ssrrec.pdf>. These completed forms, along with all other requested documents, should be submitted to either the Office of Financial Aid & Scholarships (OFA&S) on the main CSUB campus, or the Administrative Information Desk located in Administration Building 100 at the Antelope Valley Campus. **The scholarship application deadline is Friday, May 13, 2005.**
