## George A. Nielsen Public Investor Scholarship - FAH (Vol. 7, No. 15)

**Scholarship Available for Undergraduate or Graduate Students of Public Administration, Finance, Business Administration or a Related Field**

Students are advised that the George A. Nielsen Public Investor Scholarship of \$5,000 is available for award in 2006 (may be awarded as two \$2,500 scholarships) to an undergraduate or graduate student in public administration, finance, business administration or a related field. The purpose of the George A. Nielsen Public Investor Scholarship is to support the studies of full- or part-time undergraduate or graduate students with a career interest in the efficient and productive investment of public funds.

### Eligibility:

- Employed at least one year by a state, local government or other public entity.
- Recommendation by your employer.
- Enrollment in an undergraduate or graduate program in public administration, finance, business administration or a related field, before funds are awarded.
- Citizen or permanent resident of the United States or Canada.
- Student has not been a past winner of a scholarship program administered by the Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA) of the United States and Canada.
