Scholarship Available for Undergraduate or Graduate Accounting Students

Students are advised that the 2006 Frank L. Greathouse Government Accounting Scholarship of \$3,500 is available for award to one or more undergraduate or graduate students enrolled in full-time study preparing for a career in state and local government finance. The winner will be invited to attend the Government Finance Officers Association's annual conference in Montreal, Canada, May 7-10, 2006, where the award will be presented.

Eligibility:

- Currently a full-time student in an undergraduate or graduate accounting program preparing for a career in state and local government finance. Undergraduate students must be in the process of completing at least their junior year by the time the scholarship is awarded.
- Citizen or permanent resident of the United States or Canada.
- Recommendation by student's academic advisor or the chair of the accounting program.
- Student has not been a past winner of a scholarship program administered by the Government Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada.
