## 2006 Health Professions Education Foundation - FAH (Vol. 7, No. 36)

Students are advised that the Health Professions Education Foundation has announced the availability of their 2006 scholarships and loan repayment applications. They are accepting applications for the following programs:

### Registered Nurse Education Program

- Pre-Nursing Scholarships up to \$4,000 (only for Central Valley students)
- ADN Scholarships up to \$8,000
- BSN Scholarships up to \$10,000
- RN Loan Repayment up to \$10,000. (only for graduates of BSN programs)

### Allied Healthcare Scholarship Program

- Up to \$2,500 for students at 2-year colleges
- Up to \$3,000 for students at 4-year colleges

**Health Professions Scholarship and Loan Repayment Programs** (*March Cycle ONLY*) available for dentists, dental hygienists, nurse practitioners, certified nurse midwives, and physician assistants.

- HP Scholarships up to \$10,000
- HP Loan Repayment up to \$20,000 (only for graduates of the HPSP programs)

The postmark deadline for each program is *March 24, 2006*, and *September 11, 2006*, unless otherwise indicated.
