Students are advised that this scholarship fund has been established to assist students in designated communities, who plan to continue education in college or vocational school programs. Scholarships are offered each year for full-time study at an accredited institution of the student's choice.

Postmark deadline - Tuesday, *February 28, 2006*

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

All applicants must:

- be either a graduate or senior from a Kern County High School
- be considered a full-time student (i.e. 12 units)
- achieve at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA while in high school or a 2.5 term GPA while in college

OTHER INFORMATION

Scholarships are competitive and will be awarded for one year of full-time continued study or training. This scholarship is not automatically renewed. You must apply on or before *February 28, 2006*, prior to your anticipated year of study. If a student is awarded a scholarship by the committee and at any time during the award year does not meet the said requirements, the student may be dropped from the award program.

Monies not paid out by the end of the scholastic year due to failure of the recipient to meet requirements will not be carried over to the next year and shall revert to the Nichols Scholarship Trust.
