## Kern County Fire Department Scholarships - FAH (Vol. 7, No. 49)

Students are advised that a total of six (6) book scholarships are being offered by Kern County Fire Department Ladies' Auxiliary and Kern County Firefighters' Welfare and Benefit Association organizations for the 2005-2006 school year.

These scholarships are being offered to the children of Kern County Fire Department personnel.

Six scholarships in the amount of \$800 each will be given. An additional \$400 will be given to the top-rated scholar from the Oliver Watson Memorial Scholarship Fund.

Applications are reviewed and winners selected by an independent selection committee made up of representatives from the Kern County Superintendent of Schools Office.

Two of the six scholarships being offered may be used to attend trade schools. One male and one female recipient may be chosen.

An additional \$1000 scholarship will be offered from the Ray Elliott Memorial Scholarship Fund. This scholarship will be based on student involvement, minimum GPA of 3.0, attendance at a four-year college/university or transfer student to a four-year college/university. Applications will be reviewed and selected by the Ray Elliott Memorial Selection Committee.
