## CSUB Scholarship Opportunities through SPARC & MARC U\*STAR - FAH (Vol. 9, No. 2)

Students are advised that the Math Teacher Initiative is accepting applications now for this year's program. Math Teacher Initiative, or MTI, is a program designed to double the number of prospective high school mathematics teachers who graduate from CSUB. Awards are based on merit and on intentions of becoming a mathematics high school teacher in a Kern County school.

Award amount: \$6,800 for two years PLUS assistance in applying for the APLE loan assumption program, which pays off your student loans while you are working as a teacher.

Eligibility:     Minimum 2.5 GPA  
                  Expected graduation date of Spring, 2009 for bachelor's degree  
                  Willingness to change majors to the mathematics teaching track  
                  Career goal of becoming a high school mathematics teacher.

Non-math majors interested in switching majors are highly encouraged to apply.
