**Honors Course Contract** 

**Helen Hawk Honors Program** 

**Purpose:** Hawk Honors students can submit an Honors contract in order to conduct honors level work in a

course that is not otherwise available as an honors course.

Eligibility: To be eligible for an Honors contract, students must be enrolled in the Hawk Honors Program and

to have fulfilled the prerequisites for the course they wish to take. This process is limited to one (1) course.

**Procedure:** 

1. Meet with a professor of the course.

2. Develop a plan of study that is at least one paragraph in length.

3. Develop a detailed description of tangible evidence of honors caliber work that is at least one paragraph

in length.

4. Obtain the professor's signature.

5. Obtain the department chair's signature.

6. Submit the application to the Director of the Honors Program, Dr. Jackie Kegley, FT 103D.

Deadline: THE CONTRACT FORM SHOULD BE SUBMITTED BY WEEK 8 OF THE PREVIOUS

QUARTER IN WHICH YOUR CONTRACT IS FOR. (Example: contract for spring quarter would be due

week 8 of winter quarter)

**Nature of the Work:** The type of activity outlined in the Honors contract must go beyond the normal course

content and requirements. It may include, but is not limited to, research, reading, preparation of materials, or

other work that leads to a different learning experience beyond the regular classroom activities of the course.

The student must demonstrate that he or she has developed additional knowledge and skills, above and beyond

what students normally do in the course. The form in which the students demonstrate their work is up to the

student and instructor. Students and professors are encouraged to be creative and to share their creativity with

others through presentations on and off campus. While an additional paper may be appropriate, it is not the

only or even the preferred additional activity.
