I. Check-In

Fall

Students may check in from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Friday, September 12, 2008, at the Office of Residence Life located in the Housing & Commons building. Check in will continue on Saturday, September 13, 2008 from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

NOTE: Students attending the Fall Orientation Program may register for housing on Thursday, September 11, from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Winter

Students may check in from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Monday January 5, 2009 at the Office of Residence Life located in the Housing & Commons Building.

Spring

Students may check in from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Monday, March 30, 2009, at the Office of Residence Life located in the Housing & Commons Building.

II. Payment Schedule

The following fee can be scheduled on a monthly or quarterly payment plan for the 2008-09 academic year. Indicate the meal plan of your choice on the Residence Hall License Agreement by checking the appropriate spaces under Options. **Prices are subject to change without notice.** The License Agreement does not grant Licensee permission to occupy the assigned space during the following periods: Winter Break, Spring Break, or Summer recess.

III. Financial Aid Students

Financial aid students must complete their financial aid packets and receive financial aid awards prior to admission to the residence halls. Awarded financial aid recipients can make arrangements to have their housing payments deducted from their financial aid award.

VI. Health

All students are required to provide medical and health insurance coverage. The licensee and parents of licensee are responsible for health care and emergency service that cannot be attended at the Campus Health Center.

VII. Cable Television

Cable television is in all rooms. Premium channels are available, but must be arranged directly with the cable company after arrival on campus.

VIII. Internet Access (ResNet)

Internet access is available in all rooms. In order to access the residential network, students must provide their own network interface card (NIC) and a network cable (Cat 5 or 5e with RJ-45 connections, preferably 12-25 foot length).

IX. Parking

Convenient parking is available to all students with a car. Parking permits required in all campus lots, permits available from the cashiers window in the Admin. West building.

X. Telephones

Residents may arrange for private telephone service in their room after arrival on campus by contacting the public telephone company. Campus phone is located inside the lobby of each building.

XII. What to Bring

Each room is furnished with a single bed and mattress, closet, chest of drawers, desk, chair, waste basket, vertical blinds and carpeting. Coin-operated washers and dryers are located nearby.

You will need all your own linens, study lamp, iron/board and whatever other personal items (radios, posters, etc.) you wish. The size of the rooms and lack of storage space precludes the use of additional furniture. Cooking appliances (hot plates, microwave ovens, etc.) are not allowed in the residence halls. Refrigerators cannot exceed 3 cu. ft.

NOTE: Mattress measures 34" x 80" extra long and most form-fitted twin sheets may not fit the length.
