

**Approved Concentrations for 2003-2007 Outlines for CSUB-AV**  
(One course of the concentration may be double-counted elsewhere in the major)

- 1. Double Major**
- 2. Child Development**
  - a. CAFS 200 and CAFS 414
  - b. One course selected from: CAFS 350, PSYC 310 or SOC 366
  - c. One course selected from: CAFS 312 or 313
  - d. One course selected from: CAFS 360, CRJU 340, 345, 380 (prerequisite CRJU 240 or consent of instructor), PSYC 320, SOC 364, PSYC 411, 412, 413 or 415 (all 400 level courses have PSYC 310 or instructor's permission as prerequisite)
- 3. Children's Literature**

Four courses chosen from each of the following categories, as specified.

  - a. One course selected from: English 101, 205, 207, 208, 235, 290, 294 or 295.
  - b. Three courses selected from: English 470, 471, 472, 473, THTR 307, or SPAN 422 (all of these courses have prerequisites).  
(A concentration in Children's Literature can be taken on-line through CSUB's Extended University)
- 4. Communications**
  - a. Three upper division courses selected from the following: COMM 309, 316, 360, 370, 376 or 388. b. COMM 495
- 5. Earth and Planetary Science**
  - a. PHYS 110, GEOL 201 and GEOL 202
  - b. One of the following: GEOL 309, SCI 370B or 380B
- 6. Ethnic Literature**
  - a. Take all of the following: English 207, 364 and SPAN 325
  - b. One course selected from: Eng 365, 366, 370, 372 or 395
- 7. Health & Wellness**
  - a. BIOL 320 (3 units) and BIOL 370 (3 units)
  - b. Two courses selected from: BIOL 250, 255, SCI 370A, BIOL 355 (has BIOL 255 as prerequisite), or BIOL 311
  - c. LS 496 (3 units)
- 8. Literature**

One course selected from each of the following groups:

  - a. ENGL 205, 207, 208, 235, 290, 294 or 295
  - b. ENGL 315, 316, 325, 335, 336, 337, 340, 350, 351, 360 or 361
  - c. ENGL 364, 365, 366, 372, 380, 381, 382, 383 or 384
  - d. ENGL 362, 363, 370, 373, 375, 391, 392, 393, 395, 396, 469, 470, 471, 472, 473 or 475
- 9. Life Science**
  - a. BIOL 201 and BIOL 202 and BIOL 203; b. BIOL 323
- 10. Mathematics**
  - a. MATH 191 and 192
  - b. One other Mathematics course 100 level or above, not including Math 221, 320 and 321.
  - c. MATH 494
- 11. Physical Science**
  - a. CHEM 211 and 212
  - b. PHYS 201 & 202 (these have Math 192 as prerequisite)
- 12. Diversity: Gender, Race & Ethnicity in US Society**

Select four courses, one in each category. One course may be lower-division. No course may be double-counted to satisfy both areas A & B.

  - a. African American or Native American: CRJU 330, 345, ENGL 365, HIST 465, 466, RS 365, SOC 337 or 338
  - b. Latino or Native American: CRJU 330, 345, HIST 468, RS 365, SOC 335, 338 or SPAN 425
  - c. Gender: ANTH 438, COMM 360, CRJU 325, ECON 380, ENGL 370, 375, FR 425, 426, HIST 462, INST 205, NURS 327, PEAK 430, PHIL 381, PSYCH 421 or THTR 381.
  - d. Diversity studies: ANTH 339, COMM 370, BHS 435, CRJU 430, ECON 381, ENG 420, PSYC 340, 442 or SOC 327
- 13. Science Breadth**
  - a. INST 312, SCI 370A or SCI 370C; b. SCI 360A or 360C
  - c. SCI 360B or 370B; d. SCI 350A or SCI 350B
- 14. World Civilization and Culture (no double-counted course)**
  - a. One course from the following: ANTH 250, 251, Art 201, Art 202, ENGL 290, HIST 222, 250, RS 110 or 111
  - b. One course from the following: ANTH 370, ECON 311, ECON 312, ECON 395, GEOG 302, PHIL 302, POLSI 308, POLSI 309, 322, RS 345 or 401
  - c. Two courses selected from the following: HIST 301, 302, 303, 304, 305, 306, 307, 308, 309, 325, 401, 402, 404, 422, 423, 424, 425, 426, 441, 442, 443 or 477
