

Special Education Undergraduate Programs

I. Special Minor in Special Education for Undergraduate Students

Any undergraduate student(s) may choose to complete the “Special Minor in Special Education” to fulfill their undergraduate degree requirements by completing 20 units of special education courses and 3 units of a bilingual education course. Interested students must contact Dr. Park, Dept. Chair of Special Education.

II. Integrated Special Education (ISPED)

Beginning the Winter Quarter of 2007, a new **Integrated Special Education (ISPED)** credential program is offered for the undergraduate Liberal Studies majors.

Candidates who complete this new ISPED program will receive a special education preliminary credential (“Education Specialist Credential”) in Mild/Moderate Disabilities with CLAD authorization.
