AN OVERVIEW OF SERVICES FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES (SSD)

- 1. Who are we?** We are the Office of Services for Students with Disabilities (SSD). We are also known as 'Disability Services'. As a department within the Student Services area, we fall under the administrative purview of the Vice President of Student Affairs.
- 2. Where are we?** We are located in SA 140 (next to the EOP/AAC Office) and adjacent to the Payroll Services window. At our Antelope Valley office, we are located in Building 200 (Counseling, Student Health Services, and Services for Students with Disabilities).
- 3. Why are we here?** We provide academic accommodations to currently enrolled students with disabilities. Our goal is to ensure access to students with disabilities. We strive to maintain an environment that is physically accessible to all persons with disabilities who visit our campuses. In addition, we provide disability related consultation to the campus community. We also provide training on disability related issues to faculty, staff, and students.
- 4. When can we be of assistance?** Our office hours are 8:00 am-6:00 pm, M-Th; and 8:00-5:00 pm on Fridays both here and at AV. Our out-of-class testing hours are 9:00-5:00 pm, M-F.
- 5. What services do we provide?** We provide assessment and referral, out-of-class testing, assistance with notetakers, readers, ASL Interpreters, equipment checkout, learning disability assessment, enlarged print, and coordination of other student disability related needs.
