Description

Enterprise College is a three-week summer program in economics offered by CSUB. It is offered through a CSUB-KHSD partnership. The program is sponsored by Mid-State Development Corporation. Students learn principles of leadership in addition to economic theory and applications. The course meets the standards for both senior year high school economics and an introductory college course.

College Credit

Qualified students enroll under CSUB's Young Scholars Program. Those who successfully complete the course receive credit for The Economic Way of Thinking (Economics 100, 5 quarter-units), which is transferable to any accredited college and university. Economics 100 applies toward the lower division general education requirement in social sciences at most colleges and universities.

High School Credit

Qualified students who successfully complete the course are credited for the senior year economics course at the College Preparatory level. To receive credit at the Honors level, students must earn grades of B+ or better.

Essay Contest

Enterprise College participants who successfully complete the course are eligible to participate in an essay contest. Three impartial readers judge the essays. The essay contest winner is awarded a scholarship for \$1,500 payable toward tuition at any accredited four-year college or university.

Date and Time

Enterprise College meets 8:30 -11:50 A.M., Monday through Friday, June 14 - July 2, 2010. Attendance in all class sessions is mandatory. In addition to class sessions, participants have discussions with faculty members and community leaders. Due to space limitations, qualified students are admitted on a first-come, first-served basis.

Cost

Enterprise College participation requires a non-refundable registration fee of \$100, which covers the registration fee and a class photo. Students also purchase a textbook. The actual cost of the program is considerably higher. Contributions from Mid State Development Corporation and CSUB's School of Business and Public Administration cover most of the program cost. Financial assistance is available upon a written verification of student needs by a school counselor. This letter must be mailed with the application

packet in place of the registration fee. The registration fee is refundable upon a written request received no later than June 1, 2010.

Participation

The target audience is high school students entering their senior year who carry a GPA of 3.0 or better and are enrolled in at least one College Prep or Honors course in the junior year. Graduating seniors can also attend for college credit.

Partnership

CSUB's School of Business and Public Administration coordinates Enterprise College and offers the academic program. KHSD announces the program, encourages students to apply, and provides mailing labels for eligible juniors and seniors.
