### WHO CAN JOIN?

Anyone 60 years of age, or who is retired, is welcome to join. Just complete the application and pay the current dues. For married couples, one spouse must meet the age limit, or be retired, and both must pay dues.

Those are the only requirements. You don't have to be a university graduate, or to have attended college classes. You are valued for yourself, your experience, your active and inquiring mind, and your interest in lifelong learning.

### MEETINGS

General program meetings usually take place at 2 p.m. on the second Thursday of each month on the CSUB campus. The 60+ Club also has several interest groups and volunteer groups which meet at different times and locations. Members choose the topics and activities that appeal to them.

Decisions on programs and interest groups for the year are based on member interest. Not every activity may be for every member, but that's the purpose behind the club's varied offerings: you pick and choose.

### ACTION NETWORK

The Action Network is composed of volunteers who assist CSUB in many ways. There are teams that assist with ticket-taking at performing arts and athletic events. Others care for the Walter Stiern Memorial Rose Garden and additional short-term projects for CSUB. 60+ Club members have contributed more than 65,000 hours of service to CSUB.

### INTEREST GROUPS

The 60+ Club's interest groups offer stimulating activities outside the general meetings. Each establishes its own agenda and meeting times, and most take advantage of the broad range of talent and expertise available on the CSUB campus. As membership grows, new groups form to accommodate changing interests.

The CSUB Office of Alumni Engagement and the Alumni Association sponsor the 60+ Club. As an affiliate of the Alumni Association, 60+ Club members enjoy use of the CSUB library and may participate in alumni events.
