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California State University, Bakersfield Occupational Medical Monitoring Program Medical Monitoring Declination Form

Title 8 of the California Code of Regulations requires a comprehensive medical examination before an employee is permitted to use a respirator and periodically thereafter. Medical examinations and associated tests are intended to identify adverse health effects from exposures to harmful agents, such as asbestos and lead, in order to prevent long term health effects and to ensure healthful work practices are effective. The medical examinations are at no cost to you and are performed during your normal work hours.

Because of your job classification and/or tasks you perform, you have been identified as a participant in CSUB's Occupational Medical Monitoring Program.

By signing this form, you are exercising your right to decline periodic medical examination and testing at this time. By signing this document you are acknowledging that you are aware of your rights to receive the medical examination and testing but have opted to decline.

You will continue to be included in the CSUB Occupational Medical Monitoring program and will be offered the services and medical testing on a periodic interval.
