California State University, Bakersfield Occupational Medical Monitoring Program Voluntary Hepatitis A Vaccination

As an employee of California State University, Bakersfield, your job classification requires you to be part of the California State University Occupational Medical Monitoring Program (OMMP). The University has elected to offer Hepatitis A vaccinations to employees who may contact raw sewage during the course of routine work activities. You may decline receiving the vaccination. Center for Disease Control recommends everyone receive the Hepatitis A vaccine.

The vaccine is given in two separate inoculations. An appointment has been scheduled for you at CVO on the date and time listed below:

I understand that due to my occupational exposure to raw sewage, I may be at risk of acquiring the hepatitis A virus infection. I have been given the opportunity to be vaccinated with hepatitis A vaccine, at no charge to myself. However, I decline hepatitis A vaccination at this time. I understand that by declining this vaccine, I continue to be at risk of acquiring hepatitis A, a serious disease. If in the future I continue to have occupational exposure to blood or other potentially infectious materials and I want to be vaccinated with hepatitis A vaccine, I can receive the vaccination series at no charge to me.
