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California State University, Bakersfield Occupational Medical Monitoring Program Hepatitis B Vaccination Authorization and Declination

As an employee of California State University, Bakersfield, your job classification requires you to be part of the California State University Occupational Medical Monitoring Program (OMMP). The Bloodborne Pathogen Exposure Control program is an integral part of the OMMP, as such, this program dictates that the Hepatitis B vaccination be offered at no charge to an employee who may come in contact with potentially infectious materials.

It is your right as an employee, to decline receiving the vaccination for any reason. You may later reconsider and request the vaccination at that time. The California Department of Occupational Health and Safety requires that you sign the following statement if you choose to decline the vaccination:

I understand that due to my occupational exposure to blood or other potentially infectious materials, I may be at risk of acquiring the Hepatitis B virus infection. I have been given the opportunity to be vaccinated with Hepatitis B vaccine, at no charge to myself. However, I decline Hepatitis B vaccination at this time. I understand that by declining this vaccine, I continue to be at risk of acquiring Hepatitis B a serious disease. If in the future I continue to have occupational exposure to blood or other potentially infectious materials and I want to be vaccinated with Hepatitis B vaccine, I can receive the vaccination series at no charge to me.
