What is changing?

The CSU is currently using SkillPort for employee compliance training and professional development. The CSU is replacing SkillPort with CSU Learn, a streamlined portal.

When are we upgrading the portal?

Beginning January 29, 2019, all Faculty, Staff, and Student Workers will use CSU Learn for required compliance training* instead of Skillport.

Please complete any outstanding course assignments in <u>SkillPort</u> by December 31, 2018.

All compliance and non-compliance training courses completed before December 31, 2018 will move to CSU Learn.
