Academic Standing Handbook



Academic Standings

- Academic Standings are based on your CSUB and Overall GPAs and are calculated at the end of each term.
 - **Good Standing:** CSUB/Overall GPA are at a 2.00 or higher.
 - **Academic Probation:** CSUB/Overall GPA is below a 2.00.
 - **Academic Jeopardy-Probation:** Class level GPA must be met at the end of your Jeopardy term.
 - **Academic Disqualification:** GPA has not met the requirement for Academic Probation, Jeopardy or Reinstatement.
 - **Academic Reinstatement:** Term Stats GPA must reach a 'C' average 2.00 for each term on academic reinstatement until you reach a 2.00 GPA.

Academic Probation/Disqualification

Academic Probation/Disqualification

Class Level	Total Units Earned	Good Standing	GPA for Probation	Disqualification -if GPA falls below in second semester of probation
Freshman	Up to 29.99	2.00+	1.50 – 1.99	1.49 or below
Sophomore	30-59.99	2.00+	1.70 – 1.99	1.69 or below
Junior	60-89.99	2.00+	1.85 – 1.99	1.84 or below
Senior	90 +	2.00+	1.95 – 1.99	1.94 or below

- **Academic Probation/Disqualification is determined by your class level.**
- **Example:** If you are a Freshman and have earned up to 29.99 units, the GPA for Probation is between the range of 1.50-1.99. If you stay within that range you will remain on probation until you earn more units and your class level changes or you reach a 2.00 GPA (Good Standing).
- If you fall below the 1.50 range as a freshman you will be Academically Disqualified.

Probation Holds

- All students on Academic Probation will have a probation hold placed on their **MyCSUB** student center page.
- Students must attend a probation workshop in order to have their hold removed.
- Holds will prevent registration for the upcoming term.
- Please be sure to take care of other holds such as, Financial aid, Health Center, etc

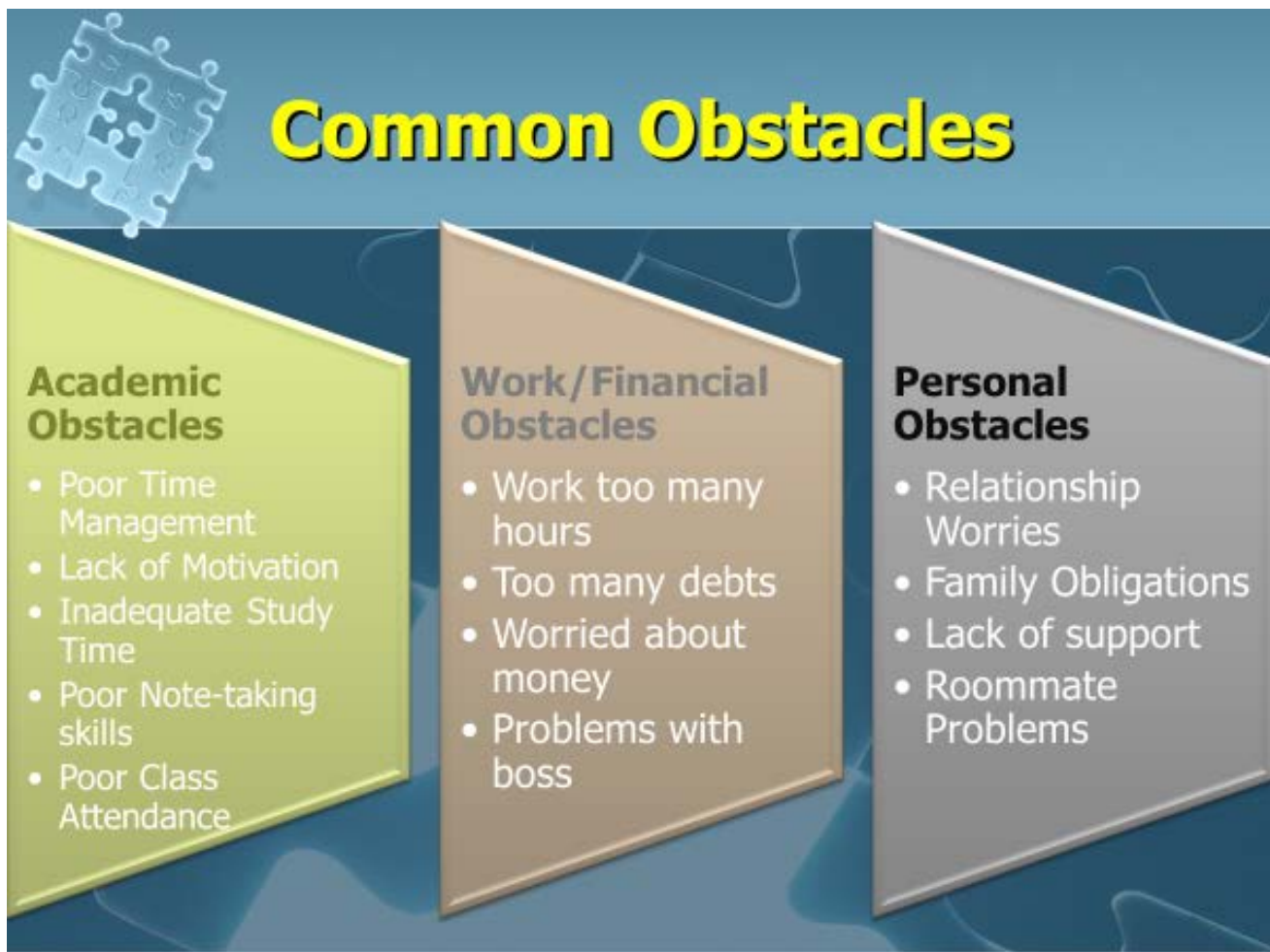
Instructions

- **Listed here are some of the common obstacles that students may face and cause them to have the academic standing of Academic Probation.**


Educational Responsibility

- **YOUR** education is **YOUR** responsibility...
- Take initiative to seek advising with your adviser in your major
- Know your academic history
- Understand degree requirements and university policies
- Use student services and resources
- **In order to graduate, you must have earned at least a 2.00 GPA in your major, minor, CSUB and Overall GPA**

Strategies for Success

- **Tutoring:**
 - Tutoring centers/tutors availability vary by location & time of the term – please check with each center & plan accordingly
- **Academic Advising:**
 - Schedule an appointment with your advisor in your major for course selection
- **Professor's Office Hours:**
 - Understand/Clarify Expectations and Requirements for courses as well from departments such as Admissions & Records and Financial Aid
- **Repeat courses for grade forgiveness:**
 - Repeating courses is the fastest way to increase your GPA.
