Debra Jackson is open to consider having a school advisor join the Graduation Initiative 2025 committee. The advisors will meet in PSA and discuss how they will approach the selection of an advisor representative for the committee.

Freshmen Housing Requirement for Fall 2021 Update

The campus would like more information about the housing requirement, and the steps to opt out, so they can provide more guidance to the students. The director of housing, Crystal Becks, may be able to join an ALT meeting and answer some questions around this matter.

- 15% of classes are face-to-face in the fall term.
- Freshmen students may be required to live in the dorms but will only be taking online classes.
- Students may not be getting the college experience if they are doing zoom classes in their dorm and do not have access to the Recreation (Rec) Center.
- What kinds of other student experiences are going to be available? Is the Rec Center going to be open? Are we going to have programming that is not over zoom?

Runner Connect

Jaimi Paschal was invited to the ALT meeting to answer questions from the group regarding privacy issues and other features in *Runner Connect*. There was a request for training with this program.

- When advisors take notes, it is part of the students records and advisors would like training on what should be included in the notes and what should not, and also what referrals can be included. Debra Jackson brought this issue to the *Runner Connect* leadership team, which has a representative from each school that includes a staff and faculty member. Based on the suggestions that were provided by the group, a document has been created, but it is not complete. Once the document is complete, it will be sent to legal, DCLC, and different constituencies.
- The privacy of the Runner Connect software is FERPA compliant. The access to view notes is by care unit, by role. As an example, an advisor cannot see something that a financial advisor puts in because the financial advisors are under the financial care unit. Unless a staff member has a dual role and handles both advising and financial advising, they can see both notes.

- The guidance in the *Runner Connect* website says to be very objective and mindful that these records can be subpoenaed. They are a permanent part of the students' records. At this time, it does not give examples, because the team is still working on an intricate document.
- Student documents should be uploaded to *OnBase* not *Runner Connect*.
- It was suggested EAB Navigator staff or CSUB designated trainers provide training for the information that is presented to the advisors and anyone using *Runner Connect*, including students.
- You can say you referred a student to the health center or the counseling center in the notes, but not specify what you referred the student to the center(s) for.
- Runner Connect was launched to staff advisors and ASC's who wanted to come on board on July 27, 2020. The program may become available for all faculty members in the beginning of the 2021 academic year. There are a few departments that came on board early and started using the software. Training will be provided for faculty.

2nd Degree Students - Processes and Procedures

There are students who are returning to get a 2^{nd} bachelor's degree, or maybe they want to get into the master's program and decide to do a 2^{nd} bachelor's, these students are treated as post baccalaureate. These students get put into a limbo because they are not referenced to any advising unit. When these students are admitted, it has to be approved by the Chair of the student's department. L. Vega will be creating a document around this issue and would like feedback from the group.

Instruction Modalities Fall 2021 Update

An updated legend with the instruction modalities will soon be showing up in the *Peoplesoft* class search. The class notes will also show up in the first search page, rather than clicking on a link to be able to see the notes. The instruction modalities are color coded based on the type of class modalities, whether they are fully online (A1), face-to-face (FTF), synchronous (S1), or flex (S2) courses. The enhancements to *Peoplesoft* are still being tested. L. Zuzarte will be sending a communication to the Student Success Network (SSN).

Additional Items

- The ALT meeting scheduled for April 26th will be postponed due to an NSME Dean candidate speaking at an open forum. We will meet again on May 3rd.
- Referral #28 from the Academic Senate was discussed during an ALT meeting (3/22/21). This item may need to be added as an agenda item during the fall for further discussion and feedback.
