



COVID-19 Safety Protocols for Suppliers / Contractors working onsite at CSU Bakersfield

Suppliers or Contractors that come onsite to CSUB are required to follow these CSUB COVID-19 Safety Protocols.

These practices are critical in reducing the spread of the COVID – 19 virus and are based on guidelines come from the Center for Disease Control (CDC), the California Department of Public Health (CDPH), and Kern County Public Health Department (KCPHD).

REQUIRED PROTOCOLS FOR SUPPLIERS/CONTRACTORS:

I. COVID-19 Screening Evaluation/Assessment

- All individuals, including Contractors, are required to complete a COVID-19 Screening Evaluation daily prior to coming on campus.
- The screening is available online at: <https://www.csub.edu/covid-screen/>
- Individuals should only come on campus after receiving a cleared to proceed to campus notice upon completion of the assessment.

II. Physical Distancing

- Maintain a minimum of 6 feet distance from others (including vendors, students, faculty, staff, and coworkers) whenever reasonably possible in all campus locations
- Face Coverings **must** be worn if less than 6 feet **without exception**
- Face covering should be worn while traveling to and from parking lots, bathrooms, breakrooms etc.

III. Face Coverings

- Contractors shall have and wear an acceptable face covering while on campus
- Contractor shall provide their own face coverings

- Acceptable face coverings include a mask, bandana, or scarf that:
 - Covers the nose and mouth
 - Fits snugly against the face with secured ties/ear loops
 - Includes at least two layers of fabric
 - Allows breathing without restriction
 - For cloth, can be laundered/machine dried without damage or change to shape
 - Represents the campus professionally - inappropriate graphics, images, wording, or logos are not acceptable.
- Acceptable alternatives (including face shields) may be approved by Environmental Health & Safety in coordination with the Student Health Center and Risk Management staff. Approval of alternative face coverings is ***required in advance***.

IV. Hygiene

- Wash hands frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds
- Use hand sanitizer (w/minimum 60% alcohol content) when hand washing is not possible
- Avoid touching eyes, nose, or face
- Cover coughs/sneezes with disposable tissues if disposable tissues are not available use the inside of your elbow to cover coughs/sneezes.
- ***Do not come on-site if ill.*** Stay at home (except to get medical care) and call your doctor if you have a fever of 100.4 or more, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever, chills, muscle pain, sore throat, loss of sense of taste or smell, unusual rash, or other flu-like symptoms.

V. Notification (URGENT)

- If contractor or supplier employee(s) have been exposed to or have contracted COVID-19 their representative must notify Erika Delamar at the Student HealthCenter at **661-654-3453**.
