JPNS 1000 Japanese I (3)

An introduction to the nature of the discipline and the fundamentals of language and culture. Development of the basic language skills: listening, speaking, reading, writing. Two hours of independent laboratory practice per week.

JPNS 1001 Japanese I Lab (1)

1-unit corequisite language laboratory to accompany JPNS 1000.

JPNS 1010 Japanese II (3)

A continuation of JPNS 1000. Oral drills, reading of selected texts, written exercises. Two hours of independent laboratory practice per week. Prerequisite: JPNS 1000.

JPNS 1011 Japanese II Lab (1)

1-unit corequisite language laboratory to accompany JPNS 1010.

JPNS 2000 Japanese III (3)

A continuation of JPNS 1000 and 1010. Continued development of the four language skills with two hours of independent laboratory practice per week. Prerequisite: JPNS 1010.

JPNS 2001 Japanese III Lab (1)

1-unit corequisite language laboratory to accompany JPNS 2000.

JPNS 2010 Japanese IV (3)

A continuation of JPNS 2000. Continued examination of the Japanese language leading to student performance at the intermediate-mid level. Focus on listening, speaking, reading, and writing, and increasing knowledge of Japanese-speaking cultures. Active use of language skills. Prerequisite: JPNS 2000 with grade of C- or better, placement, or consent of chair.

JPNS 2011 Japanese IV Lab (1)

1-unit corequisite language laboratory to accompany JPNS 2010.

JPNS 2820 Study Abroad (1-6)

Course designed for lower level study abroad credit in Japanese. Prerequisite: Consent of chair.
