Available Discounts:

NO DISCOUNTS AFTER MAY 15 -- MAXIMUM DISCOUNT IS \$50 PER CAMPER

- Returning Campers receive \$25 discount.
- Children or grandchildren of CSUB Faculty or Staff receive \$25 discount.
- Children or grandchildren of Alumni Association members (must show membership card) receive \$25 discount.
- Multi-camper or Multi-Camp discount -- Receive \$25 off 2nd camper and/or 2nd camp (applies to children living in same household/address). Discount applies to more than one child for same camp or one child in multiple camps.

Payment Plan

If you are unable to pay in full when you register, a 50% deposit will be accepted with your child's registration. Full payment must be made June 8. No deposits will be refunded after June 15. Deposits can be transferred to another child before June 8. If you pay a deposit and cancel your registration it is your responsibility to request a refund. **No refunds will be given after June 15.**

Refund Policy

If a refund is requested prior to the first day of the camp a full refund will be issued. There will be no refunds once camp begins on June 15.

Accommodation Policy

If your child has a disability and requires academic accommodations to participate in this camp, please contact our office at 654-2441 with your request. We will coordinate with the Office of Services for Students with Disabilities in order to provide appropriate accommodations. Please make your request at least two weeks before the camp start date. Many accommodations such as ASL services require extra time to coordinate.

General Information

Camp will be held on the CSUB Campus. Camp is held Monday through Thursday 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. or 1:00 to 4:00 p.m.

You will be mailed camp information approximately one week before camps begins. Camp information will include first day instructions and pick-up and drop-off information.

Parents will be required to sign and submit a "Code of Conduct" for the CSUB Children's Art Institute for registration to be processed.
