- Spring Admissions & Enrollment Updates
 - 1489 apps for Spring (1860 LY)
 - o Goal is to enroll the same number of students as last year
 - o Applications are up overall, transfer slightly down application midpoint
 - International and Graduate numbers
 - o Grad: 15% up from LY Spring numbers, credentials 4.5% up
 - International students: numbers are up compared to LY
- Fall 2022 5000+ applications received
- Re-Enrollment Initiative Dr. Jackson
 - CO sent out communication to all campus presidents to develop systemwide reenrollment campaign
 - High priority
 - Recognized that our campus has barriers in reenrollment
 - Returning students, who've been absent for 2 consecutive semesters, must reapply
 - Senate has been asked to consider that students who are in good standing, be able to return.
 - Senate being asked to revise policy for reentry students permanently

 - Students would still need to be verified by Admissions (develop a onepager how-to guide)
 - Consider any financial aid implications
 - Would need to work on system processes

- 34000+ enrolled in 2019 cohort
 - o 9600 URM students lost from 2019 cohort
 - 432 students not enrolled (CSUB)
- o Is there a way to identify students who were here last Spring, but not this Fall?
- Currently have 18 returning students who applied for spring 2022 but need reinstatement
 - Natasha Harris to send list to Dr. Jackson for follow up
- Natasha Hayes to determine if grant money can be used to help students pay fees
