- Be a California resident or have AB540 Status
- Be an undergraduate

WHAT EOP CAN OFFER...

EOP SPECIAL ADMISSIONS

Applicants not meeting the CSU Admissions eligibility criteria can be admitted through EOP.

SUMMER BRIDGE PROGRAM

A six week commuter program free of charge to incoming EOP first-time freshmen. Become part of a learning community with other EOP freshmen. Learn about university life at CSUB and earn university credit! Best of all, you're charged nothing to attend!

EOP GRANT

Students must submit a FAFSA or California Dream Act Application to be considered.

In addition, foster youth or wards of the court may qualify for additional services through the Guardian Scholars Program.

TO BE ACCEPTED INTO EOP

The following materials are required for EOP application review:

1. CSU APPLICATION

- \$55 application or apply for fee waiver

2. TRANSCRIPTS & TEST SCORES (ACT, SAT, ELM, EPT)

- Send Official Transcripts & Test Scores to CSUB Admissions

3. EOP APPLICATION DEADLINE

- Priority deadline is Nov 30th for all forms

4. FAFSA OR CALIFORNIA DREAM ACT

- CSU Bakersfield's school code is 007993 (fafsa.edu.gov).
