TO BE CONSIDERED YOU MUST:

- Have at least 60 transferable semester units
- Have an overall gpa of at least 2.00
- Have previously been either EOPS or CAL Works
- Be a California resident or have AB540 Status
- Be an undergraduate

WHAT EOP CAN OFFER...

EDUCATIONAL COUNSELING

EOP students are assigned a counselor who assist s them the entire time of their enrollment in academic, financial aid, and other school elated matters.

COMPUTER LAB

The program has its own computer lab with six stations hooked to a printer available for its student's use. Students can receive up to ten sheets of paper per printing session!

EOP GRANT

Students must submit a FAFSA or California Dream Act Application to be considered.

In addition, foster youth or wards of the court may qualify for additional services through the Guardian Scholars Program.

TO BE ACCEPTED INTO EOP

The following materials are required for EOP application review:

1. CSU APPLICATION
 - \$55 application or apply for fee waiver
2. COLLEGE TRANSCRIPTS
 - Send Official Transcripts to CSUB Admissions
3. EOP APPLICATION DEADLINE
 - Priority deadline is Nov 30th for all forms
4. FAFSA OR CALIFORNIA DREAM ACT
 - CSU Bakersfield's school code is 007993 (fafsa.edu.gov).
