Position: Coaching Assistant for Beach Volleyball (12 Month)

Position: The Assistant Beach Volleyball Coach reports to the Head Beach Volleyball Coach. As an employee of California State University, Bakersfield, you are expected to perform all duties as described below in a manner that is consistent with the overall mission of the University and department. The enhancement of our student-athletes' academic well-being, their quality of life, athletic growth, and overall character represent the primary mission of the Athletics Department.

Responsibilities: Primary responsibilities are to assist the Head Beach Volleyball Coach with coaching and training of the volleyball programs. Duties will include the following: assist in practice, prepare paperwork for the NCAA, recruiting and training athletes, scheduling, scouting opponents, game preparation, operations for travelling and home games and other University duties. The assistant coach will work with university offices such as admissions and compliance, as well as running camps and clinics. This position must comply with all University, Athletic Department, and NCAA rules and policies. In addition, the assistant coach will assist the Head Coach in providing leadership, organization, preparation, and supervision for all practices and contests.

The assistant beach volleyball coach will also communicate regularly, and work with support staff, in the following areas to assist in the implementation of the program: business office, administrators, academic advisors, sports medicine, facilities & operations, sports information, compliance office, equipment room, development office, marketing, ticket office, and weight room.

Qualifications: A bachelor's degree is required and a minimum of 1 year of beach volleyball coaching experience or having played as a beach volleyball student athlete in the NCAA level. NCAA Division I experience either playing or coaching is preferred. Experience in running and organizing summer camps and clinics is preferred. Must know the rules of volleyball and ability to work effectively with student-athletes, the head beach volleyball coach, athletic staff, alumni, and the community. This position is required to perform all duties and responsibilities in compliance with all NCAA, and institutional rules and regulations. It is the policy of California State University, Bakersfield to hire only United States citizens and aliens lawfully authorized to work in the United States. All new employees will be required to present documentation verifying their right to accept employment. You will also be requested to present a social security card at the time of initial appointment in compliance with state payroll regulations. State regulations require that every state employee sign the Oath of Allegiance prior to commencing the duties of his/her State employment, except legally employed non-citizens. These individuals are required to sign the Declaration of Permission to Work.

Background Check: A background check (including a criminal records check) must be completed satisfactorily before any candidate can be offered a position with the CSU. Failure to satisfactorily complete the background check may affect the application status of applicants or the continued employment of current CSU employees who apply for the position.

Mandated Reporter: The person holding this position is considered a "mandated reporter" under the California Child Abuse and Neglect Reporting Act and is required to comply with the requirements set forth in CSU Executive Order 1083 as a condition of employment.

Compensation: Salary and rank are dependent on qualifications and experience.
