# Student advising

**Goal:** gather information and provide accurate advising to allow students to reach their academic goals and degree in a timely fashion

## Faculty play a critical role

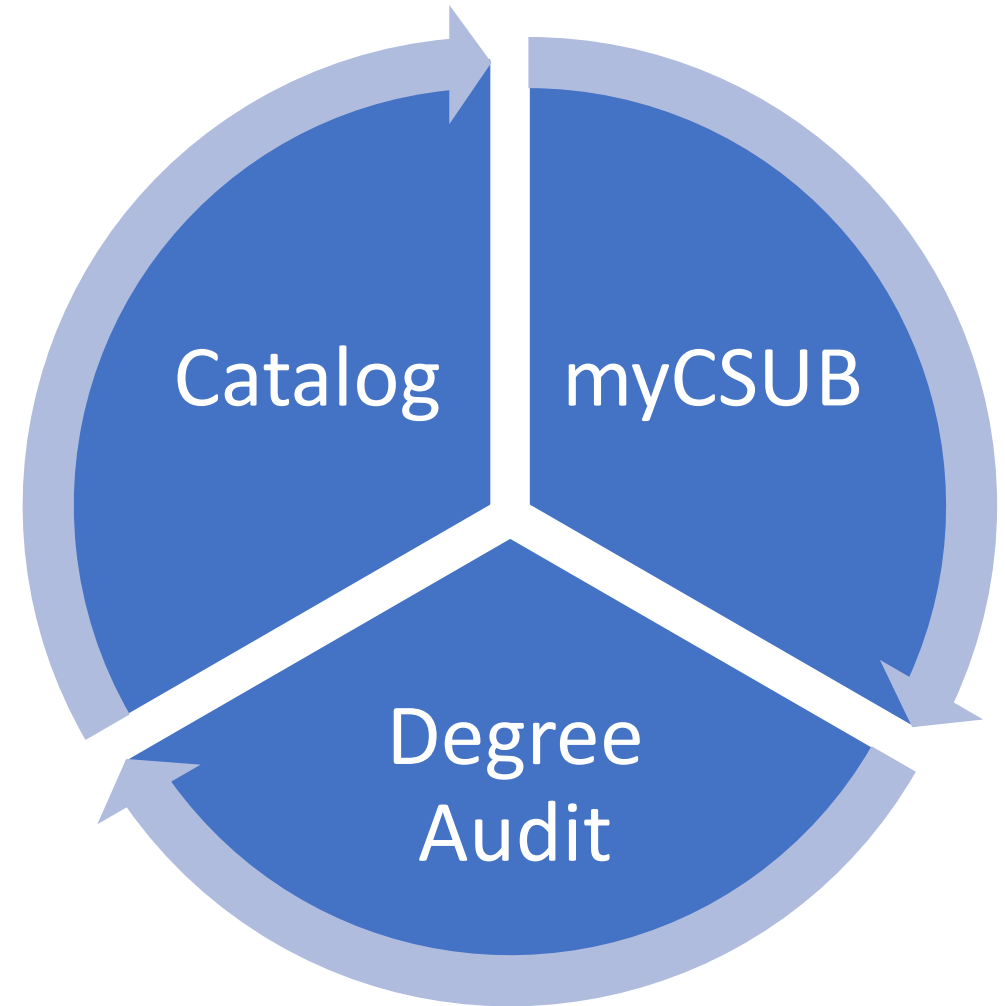
- Develop curriculum that provide the foundation for catalog and degree audit
- Roadmaps for timely degree completion



# Gathering the “facts”

## First step in step in advising

1. What is required?
2. What has been completed?
3. What still needs to be done?



# Catalog

1. Catalog year indicates the year that a student began studying at a particular institution.
2. Don't assume a student knows where to find or how to use it.
3. "Contract" with the student identifying what it takes to complete the degree and graduate.
4. Includes info about admissions, financial aid, policies and regulations, programs, course descriptions and more.

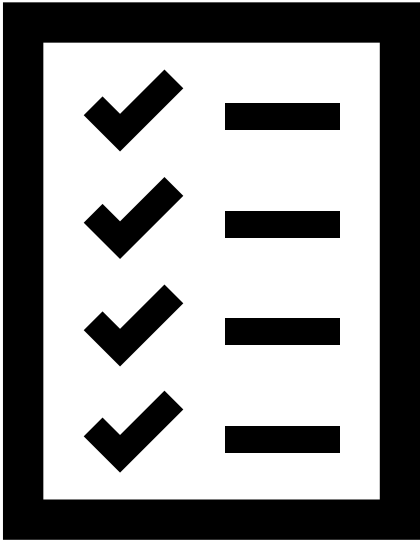
