- 1. The meeting began at 9:00
- 2. Announcements
 - a. Vandana will be taking over administrative responsibility for GECCo.
 - b. John requested that FLC leaders think about developing a SOCI question for each GE requirement that could be added to a customizable SOCI for GE instructors.
- 3. Norming session for course proposal reviews
 - a. Ongoing norming is very critical to ensure consistency
 - b. GECCo will use the same "anchor" papers for norming going forward.
 - c. We use primary trait rather than holistic scoring.
 - d. The entire group present participated in norming.
 - i. We reviewed two courses that had several categories of requirements to be met.
 - ii. We discussed the evaluation scale.
 - iii. We shared reasons for our ratings.
 - iv. We should clarify formative vs. summative feedback in the OR portion of the compendium.

- 4. Reviews
 - a. Theatre1018
 - i. There was a lengthy discussion of what a foundational skill course should contain rather than a course which reinforces a skill.
 - ii. The committee voted for a "GECCo" revision that means the course would have to come back to the entire committee if resubmitted.
 - b. Theatre1019
 - i. After a lengthy discussion of Area C and SELF requirements, we voted to invite a resubmission to GECCo.
- 5. "First in the World Grant Project"—Charles Lam
 - a. Multimillion dollar grant—student success oriented (increase graduation rate, decrease time to graduation).
 - b. SSE/NSME is applying on behalf of the university.
 - c. Needs to be innovated but utilizing proven methodologies.
 - d. Department of Education-funded.
 - e. Needs to focus on undergraduates throughout their college career.
 - f. Hope to focus on applied skills such as financial literacy, community engagement, service learning
 - i. Might fit in GPS and SELF courses
 - g. Mentoring, etc. could also be included
 - h. E-portfolios could be added on a pilot basis
 - i. Undergraduate research could be supported
 - j. We need to be careful not to increase requirements for the faculty, who are already burdened with the current program
