Discussion

- 1. The role of GECCo—document in meeting materials "Senate Approved GE Governance"
 - a. We discussed the role of GECCo and the Faculty Director in AIMS Governance
 - b. GECCo has policy, oversight authority
 - c. The Faculty Director implements policy. We need to ensure effective, ongoing communication with GECCo.
 - d. A number of suggestions for improving the AIMS advising sheets were offered.
 - e. We will have a new folder with courses by area for the fall semester.

Course Re-Submission Review

- 2. RS 4518 Resubmission.
 - a. The review was complicated by the fact that the resubmission for additional requirements does not include the previous coverage of SELF.
 - b. The SELF and Theme Q LOs are not listed in the syllabus.
 - c. The consensus was that the course is most appropriate for UD C, Theme Q, WR, CTR.

Policy

- 3. Psychology requests pre-reqs for SELF—*document in meeting materials*
 - a. Unfortunately, there was no school representative to discuss the proposal.
 - b. The committee feels it may be inappropriate to have significant prerequisites for courses in *general* education.
 - c. The unit requirements seem OK to the committee.
 - d. We will invite the department to provide more rationale for the changes.
- 4. FYS additional instructors
 - a. There was a discussion of whether people without teaching appointments should participate in AIMS.
 - b. "Faculty teaching appointment" was adopted as a qualification to teach in AIMS.
- 5. Instructor Qualifications, continued—we will take up the entire document at a later meeting.
- 6. Reconsideration of prerequisites for American Institutions—Government and American Government
 - a. The committee declined to recommend a change to the Senate of prerequisites.
- 7. Catalog rights and the "old" GE

a. Students under the old program will be allowed to register for "new" courses to fill old requirements even without the new prerequisites.
