- 1. Agenda for Friday, September 9, 2022
 - a. Steven Daniels moves to approve the agenda.

- 3. Updates
 - a. Budget
 - i. Andreas Gebauer shared that provost had allocated \$50,000 for GE. He also mentioned how most of this many had already been given out to cover chart fields, assigned time for the term and summer, and the four currently running learning communities.
 - ii. The provost is currently reviewing last year's GE expenditures and based off that will come up with a budget amount to be given to GE for the academic year.
- 4. New Course PH 3218
 - a. Steven Daniels moved to approve PH 3218 JYDR course under GE director approval and as long as the course's syllabus was updated to reflect the committee members suggestions.
 - b. Kelly O'Bannon Miller seconds to approve PH 3218 JYDR course under GE director approval and as long as the course's syllabus was updated to reflect the committee members suggestions. There is a unanimous approval.
- 5. Other Topics
 - a. There was a move to move forward with the possibility allowing students to take AI prior to full filling the A2 requirement. The committee asks that the requestor submit a justification for them to move forward with this action. Based on their justification the committee will either approve or not approve the request.
 - b. The committee discussed the role of the GE directors and that of the committee. They agreed that GECCo had the power to approve GE courses and that the GE director did not have the power to override GECCo decisions.
